KAB TAKUMA announced

RdF Power Plant Rostock handed over to Vattenfall

Berlin, May 2010: KAB Takuma GmbH, the Berlin based power station EPC contractor, informs that Vattenfall Europe New Energy Ecopower GmbH has commenced the intended commercial operation of the refuse derived /secondary fuel fired power plant in Rostock after a successful trial run operation.



The CHP, which is exclusively fired with RdF / secondary fuel, has proven its performance after several adjustments and modifications due to the changing quality of fuel, available in the market.

The main components - boiler and furnace and firing system, engineered in-house KAB Takuma in Berlin using 170,000 tons annually and - depending on the calorific value of fuel - producing 160,000 kWh electrical power, delivered to the electrical supply networks.

Another part of the generated steam, about 20 MW_{th}, is supplied to external consumers for production processes.

The power plant not only meets the technical requirements, but also substantially undercuts the emission limits required by law.
